Orca Members' Gathering at River Cruise

Highest Number of

fter the Reunion in December 1997, the new Executive Committee of Orca started think ing of a grand picnic - but with a different taste. Words spread around on the 'different taste' matter. Many members expressed their views that it could be held on the river. But preliminary assessments by the 'finance guys' concluded that it would be very expensive and opined that Orca could not afford such expenses at that time. Fortunately for us, Sami (27/1433), whose family owns a ship called Macch Ranga and plies the Buriganga regularly, contacted Orca and offered the free services of Macch Ranga for the purpose. Three Cheers for Sami! Viva le Sami Spirit! After concluding a successful and favorable 'discussions' with him, the Orca EC informed all Orca members that we could have a river cruise on 13th February 1998 which would be the first ever river cruise of the organization and cost only about Tk. 5,000 i.e., the fuel cost.

On January 15, 1998, Orea had an Ifter Party at the lawn of TMC (2/58)'s office at Dhanmondi Road-27. The party brought into light a lot of facts and thoughts that were very helpful for Orca while arranging the river cruise. On behalf of the new Orca EC, General Secretary Rafigul Haq (15/827) delivered a Gettysburg-style address that prompted sponsorships from among different batches for the following:

Breakfast & Tea 2nd Batch Lunch 16th batch Fuel

9th Batch On the fine morning of 27th February, two BRTC buses including one double decker were waiting to take the members to Sadar Ghat from Orca office at

Elephant Road. Once Vice President of Orca, Dr. Mahfuzul Haque (1/29) was very very delighted to see the double decker. So delighted was he that he was literally heard across the 'flower & bird street' thanking S. M. Salehuddin (2/67) for the arrangement. Being ushered by both these two enthusiasts, most senior members along with bhabies and children spared no time in rushing aboard the double decker. Literally forced, the 'chaos party' had no other choice but to take their 'positions' in the single deckers. The convoy reached Sadar Ghat at 9:00 am that was received by BIWTA official Bazlur Rashid (15/858). It had been long since first President of Orca M.A. Muid (2/42) had joined an Orca gathering. The river cruise brought this lull to a happy end. All were delighted to see him at the river cruise with family; he himself being actively engrossed in the programs that followed. All the time he was found assisting current President Siddigur Rahman (2/53) - what are friends and batch-mates for !! - to make the programs successful

After having sumptuous breakfast of Parata & Geela



Kolija supplemented by banana, the crowd thronged to the upper deck for the main program. Top on the agenda of the program was, however, fund raising. Renowned industrialist M.A. Muid (2/42) chaired the session and made himself successful in enlisting a lot of commitments for proposed LifeTime Subscribership (LTS) and batch-wise contributions. Thirty-six members instantly committed to be LifeTime Subscribers (LTS). For the record and information, a member who pays an amount of Tk. 10000 only at a time, becomes an LTS and gets immunity from paying any further membership fees. A list of the 36 members who committed to become LTS shortly after the river cruise is given on Page-1). Other batch-wise fund raising commitments were:

2nd batch - Taka 3 Lakhs, 3rd batch - Taka 1 Lakh and 4th batch - Taka 1 Lakh and a Musical Concert proceeds of which was to go to Orca Endowment Fund

During this session, bhabies and children on the top floor were found enjoying the scenic beauty of the river and the surroundings. Cameras were clicking now and then. When it was time for Jum'aa, the ship anchored at Munshiganj. Members were allowed I hour to offer the prayer and for site seeing. Most bhabies indulged themselves in buying pickles or boroi. In the mean time, games were going on for the children on the ship under the supervision of Rafiquzzaman (7/369).

At 2 p.m., lunch was served. The menu included Pulao, Chicken Roast, Mutton Rezala and Salad. To swallow the food down, soft drinks were supplied too. Many had to 'manage' with the shortage of food caused by over-participation and scattered 'over-eating' of some Orca members. Don't blame the over-eaters!! For them, food was good, man!! For the records, the River Cruise Food Committee had arranged for 250-300 participants while more than 350 attended. To the dismay of the over-eaters, however, many bhabies complained about the cooking standard. Culinary experts agreed. Eventually, the E.C had to apologize!

At the godhuli hour, Macch Ranga was honking the bidayee horns at the Sadar Ghat anchorage. Before the sun could really set, members alighted out of the Macch Ranga and disappeared, into the godhuli lights on shore - to their own destinations.

activities had been centered on the Reunion. There were no time and resources to engage ourselves in social welfare activities though Orca had intended to do so.


After the Reunion was over, the newly elected EC decided to go forward with social welfare programs like blood donation and providing medical services side by side with its main thrust on fund raising.
